Ken, W8LTT, is installing a TYT MF-9600 dual band transceiver in his Tesla Model S. It is the same radio he had in his Toyota Highlander. There are several challenges due the car being unconventional. The all glass top prevents a roof magnet mount antenna he used on Toyota. The newer Model S doesn't have a lead-acid 12 volt accessories battery, it has a lithium 16 volt battery, that measures about 15.4 volts.

Power problem was solved by installation of an inexpensive buck/boost device to reduce voltage to 13.6 volts. Upon hooking it to the radio for testing it worked as expected, but revealed a tag on the power cord that showed power requirement. 13.6 volts DC +15%. I hadn't noticed that before and perhaps radio will tolerate the 15.4 volts after all.

Antenna problem solved by a through-glass antenna to be mounted on fixed side window on drivers side. It includes an interesting counterpoise mounted inside. When antenna arrives, I'll finish this report in next issue. Pictures included.

Installation of an HF radio in an electric vehicle would be problematic, especially if you expected to listen while driving. The inverters driving the motors, the motors themselves and with the regeneration that engages when slowing generate a lot of noise. This as so bad they don't even offer an AM radio for the car. Operation while parked would be fine, until the DC to DC charger kicked in to charge the small battery from the high voltage battery.
