

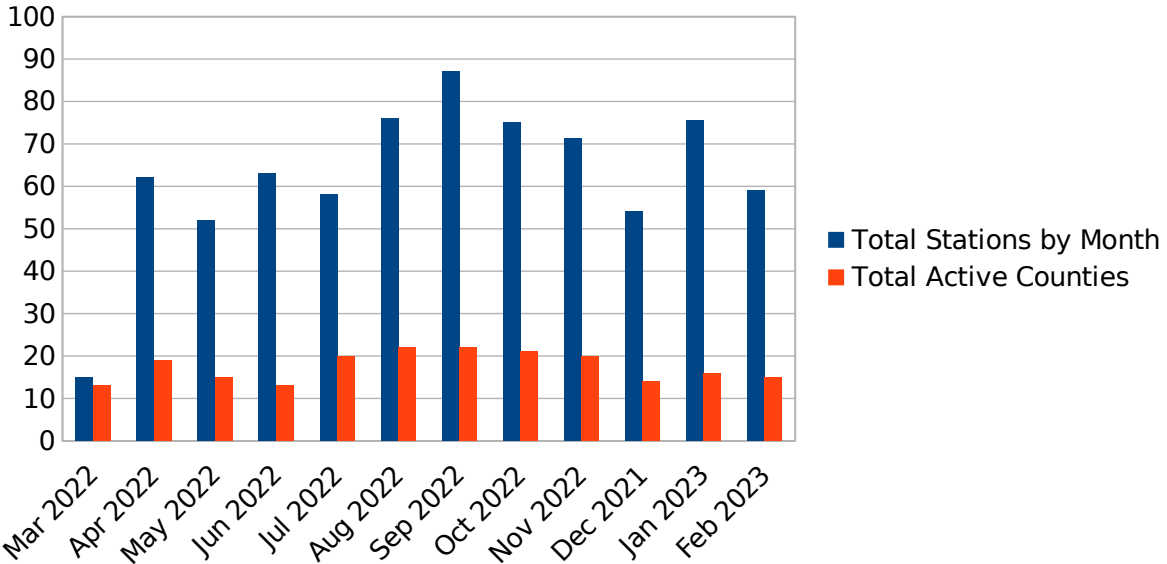

March 2022 is showing incorrect values both in the spreadsheet and the graph. I failed to generate this report at the end of February before the first net session in March and March 2023 was cleared of data to ready the next month.

February, 2023 is missing several reports from net control operators. Running simultaneous nets on 80 and 160 meters in the winter has proven successful from a readiness and resilience perspective even though the logistics of the data keeping has occasionally suffered. Even so, both total stations and total active counties data look fairly typical.

Fulton County was added this month as an active county.
